- 2. Meetings will be located in Douglas and Elbert County and will run from 9:30 to 11:30 and have a similar flow to the other coalition chapter meetings.

- 4. For the balance of 2016 the South Coalition Chapter does not have any dues and members of the South Coalition Chapter who attend the meetings regularly and have provided their name, business and contact information can access the Joint Coalition Assistance Fund and refer a senior in need. Part of the change of welcoming the South Chapter is that the JCAF fund will now apply to residents living in Elbert County. The complete list of counties covered by the JCAF fund are now to benefit seniors living in Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, Elbert and Jefferson Counties.
- 5. Starting in 2017 South members will be asked to join the Denver Senior Coalitions and pay dues.
