### **Sponsorship Opportunities**

Newsletter Sponsorship:

In the months of July, November, and March, Neighbor Network releases a newsletter to 600 clients, volunteers, donors, and community partners. It contains news about our organization, upcoming events, stories from clients and volunteers, information on aging issues, and a 150-200 word sponsor spotlight. Each issue, we hear great feedback from those who receive it. Clients especially say how it brightens their day to receive something so entertaining and interesting, instead of the typical bills and junk mail. We seek one sponsor per issue and ask for \$500 to help cover the costs of printing and mailing.

Holiday Party:

Our annual Holiday Party brings 120-180 clients, volunteers, and community partners together for food, entertainment, and holiday cheer. Our clients receive holiday gifts, which are donated from one of our community partners, and we have live music for entertainment. Each year, clients tell us how nice it is to get out of the house and celebrate the holiday season. Sponsors have the opportunity to assist with food and drink, venue, entertainment, and decorations. Typically, we seek 3-5 sponsors each year.
