The Facts

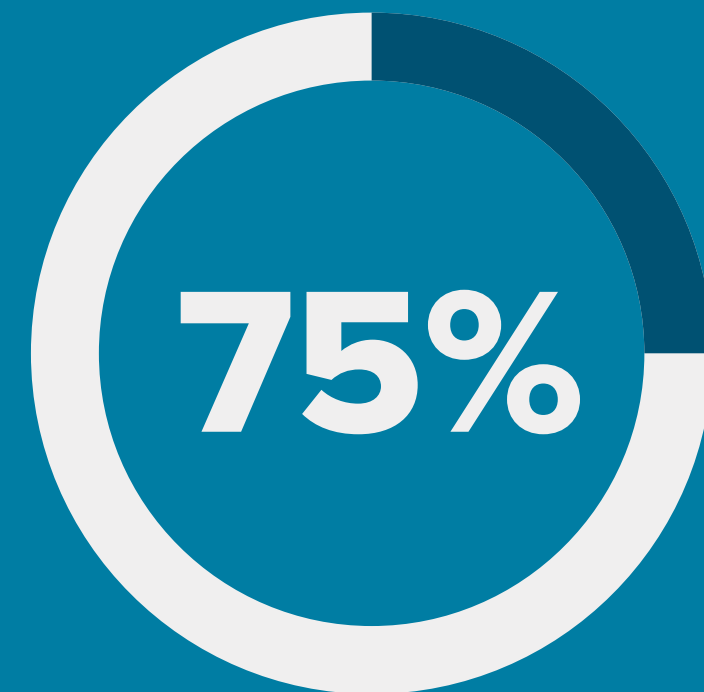

How We Work

Matches can be made once a person completes their profile at www.oddcoupleshousing.com. Users complete a home sharing and personality survey. Then, Odd Couples Housing has a proprietary matching algorithm that helps homeowners and seekers find their best match. Our product matches both parties on the basis of qualities shown to suit their closest match.

Throughout the process, one of our match team members guides homeowners and seekers through the process until move-in.
